WEALDSTONE are one of the fastest-growing football clubs in the country.. and one of the most illustrious names in non-league football.

Since moving to Ruislip from their central Harrow base five years ago, crowds have doubled to a league average of well over 500, creating an exciting atmosphere in the compact Grosvenor Vale Stadium.

Many of the fans are youngsters, with the club reaching into the community by running 18 boys' sides (under-7s through to under-17s) and senior and under-18s ladies teams who were all-conquering last season.

Wealdstone also run a reserve team in the Capital League and an Under-18 outfit in the Conference Youth League. Add to the mix a vibrant social club (Ruislip Social club, www.ruislipsocialclub.co.uk) with three bars and events most nights of the week and you can see why the place is such a success story.

THE 113-year-old club can also boast a string of notable achievements. Stones were the..

- **FIRST** team to do the non-league 'double' (winning the FA Trophy and Conference National title in the same season);
- **FIRST** team to appear in a live televised match; and the
- **FIRST** team to appear in a televised FA Cup tie.

Wealdstone have also played three times in cup finals at Wembley Stadium... and won all three of them.

Famous former stars include the ex-England captain Stuart Pearce, and Wales skipper Vinny Jones – and ex-Everton sharp shooter Jermaine Beckford – who all started their careers at Wealdstone.

Forced to leave their Station Road home in Harrow in 1991 (now the site of Tesco's), Wealdstone endured 17 years of ground-sharing before moving to the old Ruislip Manor Ground at Grosvenor Vale in 2008. Since then they have been slowly but surely developing the stadium into a venue fit for top flight non-league football.

In 2009-10 Stones reached the first round of the FA Cup for the first time in more than twenty years, losing a thriller 3-2 to Rotherham United in front of the ITV cameras.

Two years ago Stones finished fourth in the Ryman Premier League and beat Cambridge United, Barrow and Dartford in the FA Trophy before losing out in a two-legged semi-final to Newport in front of over 2,000 at Ruislip. Last season we again made the Ryman Premier play-offs but were again beaten in the semi-finals.

Our crowds have grown every year since the club moved to Ruislip and the upwards curve continues. Come and be a part of the Wealdstone revolution!
