It took the 'Stones' seven minutes to take the lead when Clive Jones drove the ball past Rose following a corner. Five minutes later Jim Bennett made it 2—0 when he cleverly headed past Rose from a free-kick taken by McPhee.

The Woking crowd was getting irritable over their side's poor show, and the 'Stones' should have taken advantage, but were looking a little scrappy themselves.

Just on half-time Jim Bennett received a pass 35 yards from the Woking goal, teeing the ball up, he volleyed home a great shot which flashed into the roof of the net.

Within two minutes of the restart, Woking scored when a centre found their centre forward unmarked and he promptly netted.

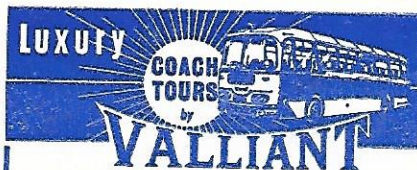
Bookings for the next away match will be taken as soon as details are known.
