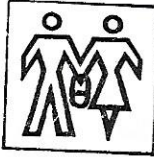

Stowmarket Football Club

Stowmarket was formed in the early century but there was a lapse of some years in the 1930's and the present club came into being in 1935

starting as a junior club under the name of Stowmarket Corinthians. The name was changed in 1948 to Stowmarket F.C. and progressed from junior football to senior status via Essex Suffolk Border League.

In 1952 the club gained admission to the Eastern Counties League which is made up of professional sides; over the last five seasons the Club has always been in the top five but have never won the League Championship. Stowmarket have been in the first round proper of the Amateur Cup for the last three seasons and in that time have lost at Kingston to Kingstonians 1-0; lost at home to St. Albans 1-0 and lost to our old rivals Alvechurch 3-2 after drawing 2-2 at Stowmarket.

Since the war Stowmarket have won the County Senior Cup four times and the Premier Cup once which in itself is a record, being the only amateur club to do so.
