£100,000 deal reported to bring international duo to Sudbury

Wasps quiet on French connection

WASPS are tight lipped about reports that they are plunging into the European market to sign French internationals Olivier Roumat and Philippe Sella.

Transfer talks with 29 year old lock Roumat were said to be 'imminent' with a two year deal believed to be worth more than £100,000, being offered.

Sella, 33, who is anxious to end his business empire following his retirement from international rugby, would cost considerably less. His ambition is to play in the European Cup and with Wasps well placed to secure a spot in next season's competition, they would clearly have greater appeal for Sella than London rivals Saracens, who are also understood to be looking to sign him.

However, there was no official word from Sudbury either to confirm or deny the reports. It was left to club coach Rob Smith to pass the only comment - "garbage" he said.

Hardly surprisingly, Wasps have received an away tie in the quarter-final draw for the Pilkington Cup, made at Twickenham on Monday.

They will visit the winners of the tie between Nottingham and Gloucester on Saturday February 24.

It is the eighth time in a row that the Sudbury club have failed to earn a home game.

However, having to face either a Second Division side, or a struggling First Division club that they have already comfortably beaten away from home in the League this season, they will be confident of securing a semi-final place.

The last time Wasps had a home cup tie was in the semi-finals in 1993 when they were beaten by Harlequins.

Tomorrow (Friday) evening, weather permitting, Wasps have a pre-international cup fixture against Bridgend at Sudbury, kick off 7.30pm.

Bans make life difficult for the bosses

PLAYER suspensions will cause selection headaches for most of the local soccer bosses this week.

With their match against Tooting called off, Wembley's 'suspended six' have their bans carried forward to this Saturday's vital visit to bottom of the table Barking.

Paul Shields, Steve Lawrence, Wayne Walters, Yousef Saleh, Ibrahima Coulibaly and Ashley Cumberbatch will therefore all be on the sidelines for a game the Lions must win to keep the spectre of relegation at bay.

Harrow Borough will be without the banned David Clarke, Bob Dowie and Lee Enderby for their tough home game with title chasing Boreham Wood.

Nko Ekoru should return after injury but Jason Court could still be struggling. Borough have signed the 6 foot, 23 year old, former Tow Law and Evenwood Town stri-

ker, Keith Goodwin and he will be in contention for a place in the side.

Danny Buckley starts a one month suspension accrued from Sunday football indiscretions and will miss Edgware Town's visit to Hungerford. Otherwise, manager Jock McGleish has a full squad to select from.

Lee Walker has completed his suspension and is available for selection for the Wealdstone team to face Plackwell Heath on Saturday, but his skipper Steve Croad and fellow defender Ian Waugh start bans and will be missing.

Matt Tarry, a centre back signed from United Counties League side Bugbrooke, could get his first full game, while striker Steve Fraser could return after injury. Rob Tenkorang, who missed the cup win at Northwood, should return.

Stones have added to their squad by signing defender Tony Knight from Hayes.
