Tour Fund. The walk will start at 12 noon at the White Lion ground and will follow a route to Tesco in Harrow - the site


of Wealdstone's former Lower Mead ground - before returning to Edgware in time for walkers to watch the Stones v Grays Athletic match

MEMBERS of the Ryman League ground committee visited the White Lion last week to indicate to Wealdstone FC officials what improvements were required to the ground to give it an A grading.



But this season Moore has fallen victim to the fierce competition for places at the club, and his sending off in the FA Trophy at Dagenham, back in October, effectively proved to be the beginning of the end of his Wealdstone career.

He added: "Both on and off the field Fergie has been a shining example to the club and, more than anyone, he has been responsible for the success we've had in recent seasons.

Moore was not surprisingly 'gutted' by the decision. "I'm sorry to go because I've had some great times here," he said. "But the manager's made his decision and I've got to accept it."
